And *small* ones tie bows).


And Mikka was hugely excited to say,
'I can't wait to begin my first bow-tying day!'




See if you can draw Mikka and Cat's reflection in the mirror.

This Christmas is cancelled, I'm sorry to say.






What a shake! What a shock!

Well they flopped and they flapped And fell into despair — 'If we can't leave our houses, Then who'll cut my hair?!'






'We'll run out of toilet roll, syrup and bread,

And no Christmas cheer.


ACTIVITY CHALLENGE

> I could start making bows For each kid on the list!'




Mikka leapt to her feet — it was time to get going And soon a great flurry of ribbon was flowing!

Little doo-dahs and trinkets, Some frills, knicks and knacks. A few what-nots and what-sits And widgets from wax.





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


Mikka piped up, quite proudly, 'No stuff has been thieved.' (Expecting her folks Would be rather relieved.)

And of warm custard trifle!


She mused in her head.

'All these tools,' she exclaimed, 'once belonged to my Gran!' In a flash, Mikka's brain had come up with a plan.

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
'Hey beavers, hey woodpeckers! Quick, come here now! Let's get wood from these trees — Every twig, branch and bough!'


> 'We shall chisel and carve, Then with hammer and nails We'll make glockenspiels, skittles And sailboats with sails!'






Can you draw the other wooden toys Mikka has made?






Santa's snaking list needs a middle. Can you connect the two ends?
















Knitting jumpers and pandas

Making presents for every good wish that was wished.






Santa's jaw hit the floor when he witnessed the scene, 'How on earth did you do this *without a machine*?'

Are there any in there that you have on *your* list?


